The International AIDS Society meeting is taking place in Toronto, Canada, August 13-18. To coincide with this, *The Lancet* has teamed up with PRODUCT (RED) and has devoted the August 5-11 issue (*The Lancet* 2006; **368**: 423-552) to HIV/AIDS. PRODUCT (RED) was launched at the World Economic Forum earlier in 2006 to provide additional funding for the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria. *The Lancet* will contribute US \$30 000 to PRODUCT (RED) in support of this important initiative.
